- *Spirited Garden*: This garden opened in July of 1992, and is now the world's famous botanical garden with a total landscape of approximately 39,700m². The garden possesses approximately 1,700 trees, and also boasts 100,000 of its Jeju wild flowers, orchids, and other various garden trees and plants which collectively form a unique scenic harmony. This garden is visited by approximately 300,000 people annually, and remains a popular tour site for world public figures such as China's Head of State Jiang Zemin and Hu Jintao, Japan's former Prime Minister Nakasone, and more.
- *The o'sulloc Museum*: The tea museum, which first opened in September 2001, is widely known in Korea. The building takes the shape of a green tea cup. It seeks to harmonize the cultures of the West and East, and past traditions with the modern world. At the o'sulloc Tea House, not only can visitors enjoy unique o'sulloc teas, but they can relax next to the lotus pond in the indoor garden. The second floor of the building has an observatory, so visitors can enjoy the views of the nearby green tea fields and the surrounding landscape.
- *Hanzi Art Gallery*: The nation's only Dak-paper (Hanzi) Doll Museum, is located near the Soegwipo Worldcup Stadium. You will find Korean's ancient life style from the Dak-paper dolls. The Dak-paper Dolls are made by sticking hundreds of Dak-paper one by one.
- *YakchonSa Temple*: The name of this Buddhist temple means that it is a temple where medicinally beneficial spring runs throughout the year. This 5-storey Buddhist temple is beautifully located near the seaside and contains 80,000 golden statues of Buddha.
